Student Satisfaction Survey 2018-2019

IQAC conducted Student Satisfaction Survey in the year 2018-2019. 370 students participated in the survey. Twenty questions were asked in the form of objectives types and the last one was about their valuable suggestion. The consolidated table briefly depicts the percentage of the survey. 70-74% revealed syllabus was covered in the classes. 95% of them expressed that staff prepared the syllabus thoroughly and well in advance. 79% of them said that the staff communicates always and sometimes effectively in the English. 63 % of the student rated staff approaches are very good and excellent. 80% of them agreed that internal evaluation is usually fair and sometimes always. 74% of them said that Institution promotes internships, students' exchange, and field visit. Mentoring facilities are 79% significantly and very well addressed by the same. 81% agreed and strongly agreed that the college provides multiple opportunities to the students. 85% of the students agreed that teachers inform about the expected competency, course, programme, outcomes. 77% of the students expressed that staff usually and every time follow-up assigned task. 82% witnessed that concepts are illustrated and with applications. 81% and 76% respondents said that the staff were able to identify strengths and weaknesses of the students and help them to overcome the issues. 82% expressed that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, reviewing the continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process. The teachers use student-centric methods and 84% said experiential learning, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies were adopted for enhancing learning experiences. For the student's holistic formation 86% of the staff encourage them to take part in extracurricular activities. 82% of the students expressed that they were given all the soft skills to work for the world. For students joyous learning 64% of them use the ICT tools while teaching. 83% of them said that the overall teaching-learning process in the institution is good, agree, and strongly agree.
