IQAC conducted Student Satisfactory survey through online in which 332 students participated. 21 questions were asked regarding curriculum, teaching learning process, facilities provided by the college and overall experience in the college. The above table briefly describes the students' satisfaction. Concerning the syllabus coverage, 70% - 100% of the students have witnessed positively. 94% of the students expressed that teachers prepare for the classes thoroughly and satisfactorily. 75% of the students said that staff were able to communicate effectively and 62% of them described that teachers approach to students as excellent. 79% of the students agreed with the fairness in internal evaluation and assignments. 83% of the students agree and strongly agree with the Institution's interest in promoting internship, exchange field visit opportunity and provides multiple opportunities respectively. 79% of them rated excellent to the course and programme outcomes. 77% of the students agreed that the follow-up on the assigned task happens every time. 79% of them agreed that the staff detailed the text with illustration and application to understand the concept easily. 74% respondents said that the teachers identify the strength and weaknesses of the students. 76% of the students strongly agree and agree in regard with the institution's effort to engage students in monitoring and reviewing continuously on the quality improvement of the teaching and learning process. 80% of the students said that they have been encouraged to take part in extracurricular activates. 58% of them expressed that, the staff uses ICT tools for teaching. 74% of the students rated that the overall quality of teaching is good.
