### **SCHOLARSHIP**

To ensure the financial equity for Higher Education to all students, several scholarship schemes have been implemented by the Central and State Government through SC/ST Minority, Talent and CM Merit Scholarship schemes. In total 117 student beneficiaries received scholarship of Rs. 8, 82,740. Our Management concession for fees of poor students is Rs. 1, 64,962.

Library has been automated and digitalized with 16950 books and 54 magazines and 9 Journals.

Sixty one CCTV cameras are installed at strategic places.
